**REPORT ON THE ACTIVITIES OF THE FIELD STUDY STUDENTS/ STUDENT TEACHERS
FROM DIFFERENT TEACHER EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS (TEIs)**

1. Department Order No. 3, s. 2007 on the Guidelines in the Deployment of Pre-Service Teachers on Experiential Learning: Field Study & Practice Teaching stipulates that the Basic Education Schools (BES) shall provide the Teacher Education Institutions (TEIs) the authentic environment to implement the teacher education curriculum.

2. Because of this, the Division of Negros Oriental has accommodated the FSS and Practicum Students from the different TEIs all throughout the province including that of Negros Occidental through a division endorsement.

3. This office through Dr. Erlinda N. Calumpang, EPS and in charge of FSS and Student Teachers shall facilitate identification of public partner schools where they are to be deployed to avoid congestion in one school.

4. Our commitment to these TEIs is not only providing their FSS and practicum students the chance to use our classrooms as their wider laboratory but also to be their resource persons and mentors in the professional development of their students.

5. To provide us with an update of the status of the activities of the FSS/Student Teachers, all schools tapped as public partner schools of TEIs are directed to submit a status report using the attached template.

6. Details including the frequency of the submission of the report are stipulated in the template. However schools concerned may contact the focal person at any time on issues regarding FSS/student teachers that need immediate attention.
