**SEMINAR-WORKSHOP ON UNPUBLISHED VISAYAN FOLKDANCES AND PUBLISHED PHILIPPINE FOLKDANCES FOR DISTRICT TRAINING OF TEACHERS**

1. There will be a **Live-In Seminar-Workshop on Unpublished Visayan Folkdances and Published Philippine Folkdances for District Training of Teachers (TOT) on September 27 – 29, 2014 at Valencia Central School.**
2. The seminar-workshop aims to:
  - review the basic dance steps and rhythm leading to Philippine folkdances;
  - perform and master the Unpublished Visayan and Published Philippine Folkdances; and
  - capacitate teachers with skills needed in teaching folkdances in their classes
3. Participants to this Seminar-Workshop are elementary and secondary MAPEH teachers who can perform folk dances.
4. Each district should send two (2) pairs of participants, a total of four participants : one pair (male and female) from the Elementary and another pair (male and female) from the secondary.
5. All participants must be physically and mentally healthy. Pregnant women are not allowed to join. Participants are required to bring the following:
  - Medical certificate
  - Dancing attire (rubber shoes, loose pants, T-shirt, face towel)
  - Beddings (pillow, blanket, other personal effects)
  - costumes
6. Participants from the different Districts are advised to bring their assigned costumes:

Registration fee, travelling, and other incidental expenses are chargeable against Division/School MOOE/Local Funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
8. All participants must report to Valencia Central School on or before 7:00 AM of September 27, 2014. Facilitators, demonstrators, and training staff will report on September 26, 2014 at 1:00 PM for the meeting, finalization of power point presentations and rehearsal of their topics. First meal of participants is breakfast of September 6, 2014 and last meal is dinner of September 29, 2014.
9. Participants, facilitators/demonstrators, and training staff in the seminar-workshop shall be given two (2) days Compensatory Time Off/Service Credits.
