Each participant should bring their own ticket to be presented at the gate of the event venue. Each ticket has a unique code which will be scanned upon entrance. This will ensure security, safety, and participation in the activities especially in the raffle draws.

**VII. Raffle Draws**

**VIII. Teachers' Fair**

There will be a Teachers' Fair which will be set up inside the event venue. It will feature exhibits, food booths, Municipality/ City booths in Negros Occidental that will showcase their culture and products, and booths for our private partners/ companies.

**IX. Schedule of Activities**

The gates of the event venue will open as early as 5:30 AM. Booths at the Teachers' Fair will also open around this time for visiting of the participants.

There will be a morning and an afternoon program. The morning program will be composed of the various invited speakers, performances, regional cheer, games and raffle draws.

The afternoon program will be the Teachers' Got Talent contest. There will also be raffle draws in the afternoon.

## **TEACHERS' GOT TALENT**

### **Contest Guidelines**

As part of this year's World Teachers' Day Celebration at Victoria Sports and Amusement Center, Victoria City, Negros Occidental on October 4, the Department of Education, in partnership with the members of the National Teachers' Month Coordinating Council (NTMCC), will hold the Teachers' Got Talent (TGT) Competition.

1. The Contest is open to public and private school teachers from Regions 6, 7, and 8.
2. The contest is open to any type of act or performance: singing, dancing of any genre, and specialist acts of any nature. If you think you got talent, then bring it on!
3. Only one contestant (or group) per school shall be allowed to join. If joining as a group, a maximum of ten (10) members shall be allowed.
4. The presentation should last for a maximum of three (3) minutes only.
5. Each interested individual or groups shall submit a video recording of presentation (using phone or digital camera or other means) in a CD with the attached registration form to the Special Programs and Projects Office (SPAPO) of the Office of the Undersecretary for Partnerships and External Linkages. For queries, please contact SPAPO through Ms. Luzviminda dela Rosa at (02) 637 5834 / 637 5832 / 635 2456. The video recording may also be sent through any big file sending online services (e.g. WeTransfer, YouSendIt, SendSpace, FileFactory, DropBox, etc.). For entries which will be sent online, please email the link to [ldelarosa@yahoo.com](mailto:ldelarosa@yahoo.com) with Subject: "Teachers' Got Talent Entry [Name of Contestant]". All entries should be submitted not later than September 26, 2014.
6. The fifteen (15) most entertaining acts, as determined and selected by the TGT committee based on the submitted video recording will go through the finals and will be notified accordingly on October 1, 2014.
7. The TGT finals shall begin at 1:00 PM on October 4. Contestants who fail to arrive on time at the designated venue shall be disqualified.
8. After every act/ performance, two of the three judges will be available to give their comments and/or remarks.
9. At the end of all fifteen (15) performances, the scores will be tallied.
10. Announcement of winners will follow shortly.
11. The judges' decisions are final and not subject to review, debate, contest or dispute.
12. The criteria for judging are as follows:

Talent and Skill	50%
Originality and Creativity	25%
Projection and Overall Impact	25%
