1. Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum No. 146, s. 2014, entitled "2015 Conduct of National Observances and Commemorations of Historical Events and Related Activities", the National Executive Committee headed by the JCI Senate Philippines in coordination with its member agencies and associations (DepEd, CHED, TESDA, Office of the Presidential Assistant in Education, PACU and PAPSCU) will conduct a three day **National Summit on W.A.T.C.H on June 19-22, 2015 at Teachers Camp, Baguio City with the theme: W.A.T.C.H "Five Years and Beyond"** (Enclosure 1: Program of Activities).

2. The activity aims to:


- review what has been accomplished after five years of implementation;
- look at the Advocacy Five Years and Beyond;
- set new milestones so as to be always relevant with the times; and
- stamp out Filipino Time and build the value of honesty among the young as it is a continuing journey in building a good Filipino citizenry.

3. The highlight of the breakout session on the second day of the summit is the proposed WATCH activities Five Years and Beyond, and the choice of Best W.A.T.C.H School MTV (Enclosure 2: Mechanics of Competition).

4. Participants to this activity are the Regional Assistant Directors (17), Regional Special Events Coordinators (17), Assistant Schools Division Superintendents (217), Division Special Events Coordinators (217), Educational Program Supervisors, School Principals, School WATCH Coordinators, Subject Area Coordinators and Institutional members of Boy and Girl Scouts Council. Attendance of the participants shall be on **official business**.

5. Private school principals and or subject area heads are encouraged to attend this summit. They are advised to make arrangements with their respective schools with regard to the registration fee and travel expenses.

6. Previous winners, school principals and WATCH coordinators, are enjoined to attend the summit and to submit a 7-10 minute WATCH MTV (CDVD Format) for evaluation (Enclosure 4: List of Previous Winners).
7. A registration fee of **Five Thousand Pesos (P5,000.00)** shall cover the board and lodging during the conference, meals (breakfast (3), snacks (6), lunch (3) and dinner (3), seminar kits), materials and honoraria for the speakers and facilitators. Meals shall be served starting p.m. snack on Day 0 and ending with lunch on Day 3.
8. Travel expenses (transportation and per diem) of the National Secretariat (SEU) and other incidental expenses to be incurred relative to this summit shall be charged against OSEC funds while the travel expenses (transportation and per diem) and registration fee of the participants shall be charged to local funds, regional/division MOOE, PTA/PTCA funds, local school board funds and other sources subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
