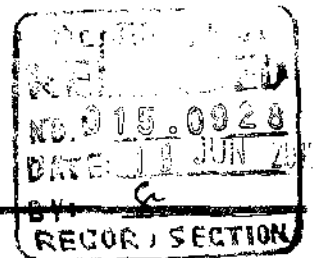

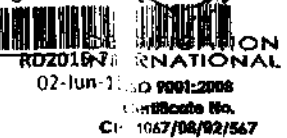

Dear Dr. Jeruta:

This is in connection to the letter we sent last March 30, 2015 regarding the program entitled, "Sustained Nationwide Dengue Vector Surveillance Thru Ovipositor (OL) Trap." We would like to request for the attendance of the OL Trap School Coordinators of all the select sentinel schools and the Health and Nutrition Program heads/coordinators from the 11 school divisions to the "Sustained Nationwide Dengue Vector Surveillance Thru Ovipositor (OL) Trap" program re-orientation.

The active participation of the Department of Education in the project has been beneficial to the control of the dengue vector and in fact, together with the rest of the integrated dengue vector management, the country was able to lower the dengue cases in 2014 by 59.57% according to the National Epidemiology Center of the Philippines' Department of Health.

With this result, we find the need to extend the implementation and monitoring of the project to continue the efforts to address the dengue situation in the country.

Thus, we have scheduled a re-orientation for the extension of the implementation of the project in the provinces in June and July 2015. Enclosed is the schedule of the re-orientation.

The re-orientation would discuss the following:


1. Review of the procedure of the installation of the O-L Trap kits
